
THIRD THURSDAY PREVIEW

A low-key presentation by E. A. Heidel, a staff chemist at the O'Brien Corp. (Fuller O'Brien) in South San Francisco provided the lecture for the evening after Bordens had to cancel. The technical information given was extensive and far too much to cover here. But one test that he described is a simple and useful one. To see if your lacquered surface is wellapplied and thoroughly dry, take a nickel coin and try (in an inconspicuous place). to scratch the surface. If the wood dents but the finish stays intact the finish is up to snuff.

BAWA needs to fill the other secretarial position so that more hands and typewriters are available to produce reports on the meetings. Volunteers should get in touch with anyone on the executive committee. This is your chance to have a title.




