


# LAST MEETING



All postage is paid by BAWA. If the tape is issued at a meeting a packet with stamps, tape and a mailing label will be included so all you have to do is drop it in a mail box.


You may also mail in a request with 2 dollars and your tape will be sent to you postpaid with the same provisions as above.
