
MARCH MEETING





LAST MEETING

The February BAWA meeting was held at the Castro Valley High School wood shop and featured talks presented by furniture refinisher Harry Francis and BAWA member Dick Taylor. Prior to the scheduled program was a short business meeting at which BAWA treasurer Scott Eisenburg presented a financial report on the current status of BAWA and secretary Chris Crawford read the minutes of the previous general and board meetings. BAWA president Woody Woodward announced the appointment of the following committee chairmen:

A number of BAWA members are already working on these committees and we welcome all members to participate and get involved in helping get the job done.

After the business portion of the meeting, Harry Francis, of Francis Refinishing, shared some of the techniques he has learned during his 40 years of experience in the refinishing and finish repair business. Harry gave a demonstration on the methods he uses to repair a scratched finish, including the use of Dry Colors to match the existing finish and then rubbing the affected area out with a french polishing method. Harry then demonstrated, on the same table top, how to completely strip and refinsh a surface.


After a short break, BAWA member and multi-talented woodworking professional Dick Taylor discussed his new multiple-drill machine which simultaneously drills 19 holes in panels to be used in the 32mm cabinetmaking system. The 32mm system allows the cabinetmaker a great deal of versatility in designing the layout of drawers, shelves and doors while maintaining efficient production times. Dick filled the remainder of the evening with an energetic, non-stop discussion of desk designing, edgebanding, countertops, laminating, post-forming and the virtues of getting the most out of a 39¢ paint brush. Dick promises not to be so reserved the next time he talks!

As usual, the February meeting was accented by many good questions from those members in attendance We thank Harry for his informative talk and Dick for both his talk and for hosting the February meeting.
