



### LAST MEETING


Our September 20th meeting was held at BMD Wilsonart Distributor, 111-C Uranium Drive, Sunnyvale, California.

Woody introduced Anthony Damiano, Product Consultant for BMD Industrial Distribution. Mr. Damiano introduced the other sales representatives that were involved in Wilsonart products. There were six stations throughout the warehouse, and we were all divided into groups. Each group spent approximately fifteen minutes at each station. We were shown the different decorative laminate products, the different applications and types of glues used to install the products. The special tools that were used and artistic ideas that were presented to everyone was interesting.

Carrie Flower was at Station No. 1. She was the specification representative for Wilsonart products. We were shown different decorative laminates materials manufactured by Wilsonart. Solicor Colorthrough Decorative Laminate is just one of several type of laminates manufactured by Wilsonart. It is a special surfacing laminate with a decorative color throughout the thickness of the sheet. It is intended for interior horizontal and vertical surfaces where the face and exposed edges of the laminate should be the same color. It comes in 110 different colors. Another product is Wilsonart Decorative Metals. It is designed for vertical interior applications where special accent is required or a special mood is desired. Another Wilsonart product is Decorative Tambours. It is in a variety of decorative faces and product compositions for vertical

surface use. They are used on all types of wall surfaces.

Mike Martin was at Station No. 2 and explained in detail all about the L.J. Smith Stair Systems. You can order custom made rails, baluster, and shoerails in a variety of styles and sizes. Mike also featured several types of stairs: U-type stairs, circular and spiral stairways. These are hand crafted and pre-assembled. A special E-Z Lock feature is used on the spiral staircases. It has the strength of a steel cantilever connector to join the tread to the post. Stability is assured in one simple assembly. No additional lag screwing is required.

Station No. 3 was manned by Buddy Mohler with a display of the different adhesives that Wilsonart manufactures and uses on their laminates. They also make wood glues called LOKWELD 10 white fast setting, LOKWELD 20 yellow fast drying and aliphatic resin wood glue. Wilsonart manufactures 5 PVA adhesives in various sizes that are not flammable. They also manufacture 3 solvents and 1 cleaner that is flammable.

Scott Buchman, a product consultant for BMD, was at Station 4 demonstrating a product called AVONITE. It looks like stone and cuts like wood. It is a man-made composite that is half the weight of stone and duplicates the rich colors of granite, marble and onyx. It resists stains and is durable, and it can be cut, drilled and sanded like a piece of hardwood. It can be used for counter tops, bars, in kitchens, baths, reception desks, walls and columns. The use is almost limitless, as is the different shades of colors. Standard sheet sizes are 26"x 121", 1/2" and 3/4" thick.

Mark Ross was at Station 5 to show how to install edging on table and counter tops. Perma Edge was one type of molding that Mark demonstrated. It is called Wilsonart Snap On Edge System. It was so precise that it was difficult finding the seam. This edge eliminates brown lines and the snap-on feature saves time. Mark demonstrated 5 different tools that are needed to install perma edge molding.





At the last station No. 6, Wes Powers gave a demonstration on the many different ways the solicore laminate can be glued together using different colors. He showed us a template that he made that cuts grooves through the first layer and leaves small squares that resemble tiles. Another idea was to glue unusual shapes and colors together for framing decorative wall displays. Indoor signs can be made from this material as well. They also have a video available that show the many different uses.

The evening came to a close with a drawing for 7 door prizes. Six of the prizes were the same, a tee shirt and cap with the Wilsonart logo, and a special laminate table saw fence guard to hold the laminate material flat on the table saw while cutting. The seventh prize was a 1-1/2" thick butcher block maple hardwood the size of a door. Everyone received a Wilsonart cap on the way out the door.
